

THE LORD OF THE RINGS **Full Score Read-Along**




The notes in this guide provide cues for using Howard Shore's scores for The Lord of the Rings and The Hobbit to create a continuous musical backdrop for reading J.R.R. Tolkien's The Lord of the Rings.

These cues and other timing estimates are taken from my dramatic reading cadence: a casual narration speed with character acting and natural dramatic pauses. Individual reading speeds can of course differ wildly, and these notes are intended as a guideline. There is also a major difference when reading out loud versus reading silently. My intention is to provide a starting point, and a few notable moments to aim for in the score.

Feel free to make your own choices as you see fit!

CUES & PAGE NUMBERS •

Because there are so many editions in print, cues are indicated by a short excerpt of text. Start playing the noted track when you get to that sentence! The page number is a rough reference, and may differ to your copy of The Lord of the Rings.



Page numbers are taken from *The Lord of the Rings* Revised Collector's Edition, first published in 1987.

MUSIC & TRACK NOTATION •

All tracks and cues are taken from The Lord of the Rings: Complete Recordings (Reprise Records) and The Hobbit Special Edition Original Motion Picture Soundtracks (WaterTower Music)

Tracks are notated in the format [Film #]. [Disc #]. [Track #]:

3.1.5 refers to The Return of the King, Disc 1, Track 5: Return to Edoras

Music from the Hobbit trilogy is notated with an "H":

H1.2.14 refers to An Unexpected Journey, Disc 2, Track 14: The Hill of Sorcery

START & REPEAT TIME •

Repeat a track until the next cue. PLAYS number estimates how many times a track may repeat before the next cue. This is only a reference and may differ depending on reading speed.

TIME indicates where in the track to start and end playing:

full track: Play the whole track, start to finish, before repeating.

start at [xx:xx]: Start track at noted time. Play through the end of the track and repeat, again starting at the

noted time.

[xx:xx] - [xx:xx]: play only the noted section of the track.

NOTES •

When applicable, there will be further notes on the cue. This is where I note any more specific timing direction, and - most often - any notable musical themes as they can match up with appropriate moments in the text. I will note the timestamp of the track, what is playing, and what part of the text it matches to.

end with track: Indicates that the next cue can start immediately as the track ends. This is highly dependent on reading speed and does not mean anything important; simply repeat the track as usual if needed.
